MEMORANDUM FOR RECOMMENDATION

SUBJECT: Mrs. Kelly Narowski

1. My name is CH (CPT) Pinkie Fischer, battalion chaplain for the 6<sup>th</sup> Psychological Operations Battalion (Airborne) located in Fort Bragg, NC. I want to let you know about a person you may be familiar with by name or by her reputation as a safety educator, Mrs. Kelly Narowski. She was involved in an automobile accident 13 years ago which left her paralyzed from the chest down. She has devoted her life to telling her personal story and educating Soldiers, civilians and youth about practicing safety behind the wheel. Kelly is also an Army spouse and has spoken passionately for many units at battalion, brigade, and installation levels to include Fort Lee, Fort Jackson, Fort Riley, 1<sup>st</sup> Infantry Division, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Brigade Combat Teams, 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division, the 101<sup>st</sup> Sustainment Brigade, 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Division (Air Assault), 5<sup>th</sup> Special Forces Group, 160<sup>th</sup> SOAR, and 4<sup>th</sup> Military Information Support Group (Airborne), United States Army Special Operations Command.
2. Her method of delivery is down to earth and practical and her message is on point every time she delivers. She speaks from her wheel chair putting greater emphasis on making the right decisions behind the wheel. She also includes several short video presentations, including a traffic accident involving a baby. The video and images bring the reality to every Soldier who watches and listens. In her presentation she also covers other safety topics such as fatigue, cell phone use and texting while driving.
3. I have personally attended her training several times when she presented before the entire 4<sup>th</sup> MISO Group, multiple times before the 82<sup>nd</sup> ABN brigade units, and at one of the major leadership conferences located in Southern Pines, NC. One safety officer even confirmed an overall decrease in DUI's and no POV injury accidents throughout his brigade since Kelly's presentations.
4. I highly recommend that you consider contracting her services for your next upcoming Safety stand down. Kelly's heart's desire is that Soldiers no longer become casualties of the road or contribute to the loss of human life as a result of making wrong decisions while driving.
